1. Community Health Facilitator (1 position based in Siem Reap Province, working at Svay Leu District)

Major Responsibilities:

- ♣ Work closely with other project staffs, school teachers and local authorities of Svay Leu District to achieve the project objectives related to community health as defined in the strategic planning and community development model.
- ♣ Coordinate relevant training to build capacity Village Health Support Group (VHSG), Mother Support Group (MSG) and school teachers with OD and District Education Department in compliance with training needs assessment.
- ♣ Provide direction to VHSG, community people and school teachers to participate in preparing village development plans, school health plans and ensure their implementation and monitoring especially regarding primary health care education, schools Health checkups, school gardening and WASH program.
- Assist with the MCHN nutrition program in 8 villages with quarterly child growth monitoring and health education including nutrition.
- Strengthen the HIV Prevention Mother to Child Transmission Program in your area.
- \$\bullet\$ Strengthen the Safe Motherhood program, working closely with HC Midwives and VHSG. Assist with referrals to HC and RH.
- Assist the health team with community health campaigns and events in the villages:
- ♣ Assist community and school committee to mobilize resources to take up collective activities for community and schools development work.
- ♣ Visit the health centers and schools of your areas and identify the problems with the Government staff and teachers.
- ♣ Conduct monthly monitoring visits to your target schools and villages to ensure the progress of project activities in the target areas.
- ♣ Ensure participation approach from women and poorest people in decision-making, identifying problems and promote concept of gender, right-based-approach and child protection; conduct health awareness raising activities in the target villages.
- ♣ Build relationship and trust with community people and schools' teachers and encourage target beneficiaries to participate in decision-making process.
- Build capacity to the community people by encouraging collaboration and ensuring access to a range of high quality support services; information, advice, training, mentoring, networking opportunities, etc.
- ♣ Prepare monthly work plan/activity report to the supervisor regarding to the activities in the target villages and schools.
- Communicate with relevant stakeholders (NGOs, UN, Gov't) for sharing and reflection and build up networks.

Qualifications:

- ♣ Bachelor Degree in Public Health, Degree in social sciences, Secondary Nurse or any equivalent field
- ♣ Minimum 2 years' experiences in community health promotion, school health or development with NGOs/INGOs
- Willing to work in a team, and sometimes stay overnight at the village if necessary

- ♣ Skill in formation and strengthening of grass roots level
